We supply unusual, garden and wild type cut flowers to Florists, Growers & Designers in the North West of UK.

Why buy from us?

- When you want something different, unusual, characterful. Especially those short-life flowers which do not survive international transport well. Garden gathered, foraged, material for wedding, event & installation.
- Great service & support - I do floristry too and can advise what flowers will work for what situations. We like to build great working relationships with our wholesale customers so we know what kind of flowers you like and to suggest varieties that we think you will love.
- Absolute tip-top freshness & quality, strong stems, cut ready for you to use. If anything is not up to standard, we will tell you, and try to suggest an alternative. Cut and kept in fresh water, at the right stage for you to use.
- No wasteful cello wrap - we occasionally wrap in newspaper if needed.
- You can order any number of mixed buckets or stems, not a whole wrap of one thing.
- Lots of customers are looking for locally sourced or sustainably grown material now, so sourcing from us will exceed expectations and set you apart from your competitors.
- Prices are pretty static and will not vary substantially from the Guide. No currency variations to deal with.
- Fragile, ephemeral, full blown, wonky, wild & downright beautiful - Variety, scent & character you will not find in a standard wholesaler. Maybe that bit of inspiration & joy that lifts your day beyond the mundane.

How to get the best from us:

- We grow varieties you may not know, and we do not expect you to be familiar with them. We actively prefer orders for mixed buckets picked to your colour scheme and style. This way, you may get to try something new.
- Let us know when & what you are wanting the flowers for - especially what stem length you really need, what vase life you need, whether you are using oasis foam. All of these affect the range of suitable flowers.
- Keep colours as broad as possible, so we have the best chance of supplying the quantity you may need.
- We will give preference to regular customers and those who order mixed buckets, or to a budget, or a wide range of varieties.

A bit of background information for your customers

We are small, hand-scale growers, using organic & sustainable methods, in soil and without pesticides. We are in rural West Cheshire, on the lower slopes of the Sandstone Ridge. We do not use chemical treatments on our flowers. We don't use flower food because we pick your flowers fresh and generally don't store them for more than a day.

Please read the following information and terms. Placing an order indicates that you have read and accept them.

Reservations, up to 1 year ahead:

- Our Flower Guide for the year is attached, showing general varieties and when they should be available. This is a guide only, exact timings and prices will vary, and we have many more varieties than we can show on this list.
- You can make reservations to reserve flowers for an event - by colour, style, budget or by approx stem count, up to 12 months in advance.
- Reservations and orders will not be confirmed until the week before the event.

Weekly Availability

- At the beginning of each week, if we have flowers not already reserved, we usually send an availability & price list, to our wholesale distribution list, by mailchimp. Orders will be taken out of this list before release. If there are insufficient flowers left after orders, a list will not be sent out.
- Prices on the weekly availability list may differ slightly from the Guide
- From this list, you can order by stem, bucket or to a budget.
- There will always be other items available which are not included on the list, e.g. if there aren't lots of them, or they are unusual varieties.

- Orders are not accepted until we confirm them with you. Once confirmed, orders are considered binding and cannot be cancelled by you.

Terms:

- There is a minimum order of £39 (one mixed bucket or equivalent)
- Orders should be made by email, please
- A delivery note will usually be issued with the flowers, and an invoice sent by email. Please pay by direct bank transfer within 14 days of invoice
- We will make every effort to fulfill orders, but cannot be held accountable for crop failures. We will endeavour to notify you of any issues at the first opportunity and to offer alternatives where possible.

Collection/Delivery:

- Collect: you can arrange to pick up from here. We only pick to order, so there will not be a range of ready-cut flowers to select from.
- Delivery: We usually deliver to Manchester & East Cheshire up to 1 hour distance, usually on Thursdays, possibly elsewhere too, according to orders. Delivery charge is a fixed £25 on orders up to £100, free on orders over £100, all at our discretion. Deliveries over this distance by negotiation. We reserve the right to withdraw the option of delivery.
